



# Maples Kenwal Brar Excellence and Integrity Scholarship

The Maples Monarchs Excellence and Integrity Scholarship recognizes two students annually – one male and one female – with a scholarship of \$250.00 each. The scholarship recognizes students who display outstanding personal integrity and strength of moral character, who strive for excellence in both their sports and academic pursuits while maintaining a high level of civic virtue either through volunteerism in their community or through support and leadership displayed toward academic peers and sports teammates.

## Criteria

- Candidates must be graduating from grade 12, be enrolled to enter into either a university or college program in the following year, and must maintain at least a C+ grade average
- Candidates must be registered in either the Maples Monarchs basketball program or a Maples Collegiate basketball program and be students of Maples Collegiate
- Candidates must reside in the Seven Oaks School Division and must be Canadian citizens or landed immigrants

All candidate information as it pertains to this scholarship is subject to verification through Maples Collegiate.

## Nomination, Deadline, Judging, Awards

Candidates will be nominated by their school or community centre coach by filling out the attached nomination form. Deadline for nominations is March 1 of every year. Nomination forms will be submitted to the Maples Basketball convener for judging and awards will be announced by March 31 of each year. The scholarship will be awarded each year for as long as funds are available. All decisions made by the award panel are final.
