

## Meeting The Needs Of Our Neighbourhoods

In 2013 the Maples Community Centre received a substantial grant to proceed with a feasibility study. Prairie Architects Inc. was hired and a committee of community volunteers and City of Winnipeg representatives has worked hard to assess needs and develop exciting design drawings that highlight the project and provide a cost estimate. These were obtained with consultation with community meetings, city advisers and the MRAI Board. The next steps include developing a proposed business plan and then seeking funding partners and beginning a capital campaign. Our plans are ambitious (approximately \$24 million) but are necessary to meet the current and future needs of our growing community.

In order for this project to move forward we will need partners. We will be seeking help from all levels of government through various grants. However, we importantly need the support of our residents; that's you. We need you to let your elected representatives know that our current facility is inadequate to serve our expanding community. As well, we will need you to support our capital campaign as we fund-raise for this exciting project. When asked, we hope you will lend your support; both financially and as a volunteer on various committees as our fundraising campaign develops.

## Serving the Community Since 1970

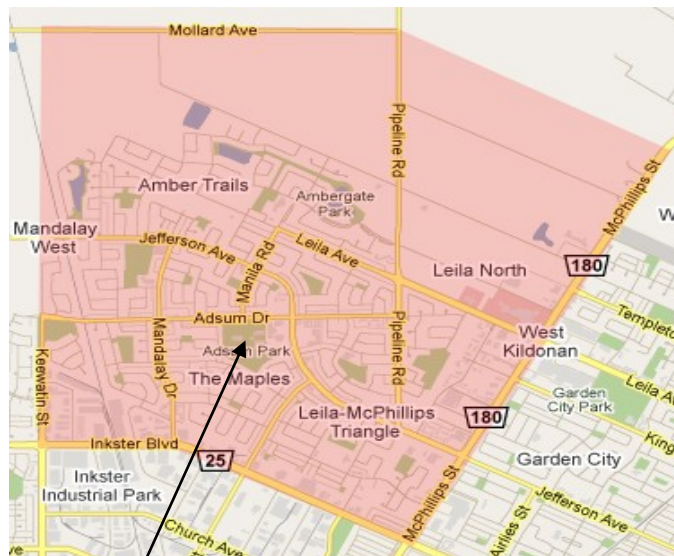

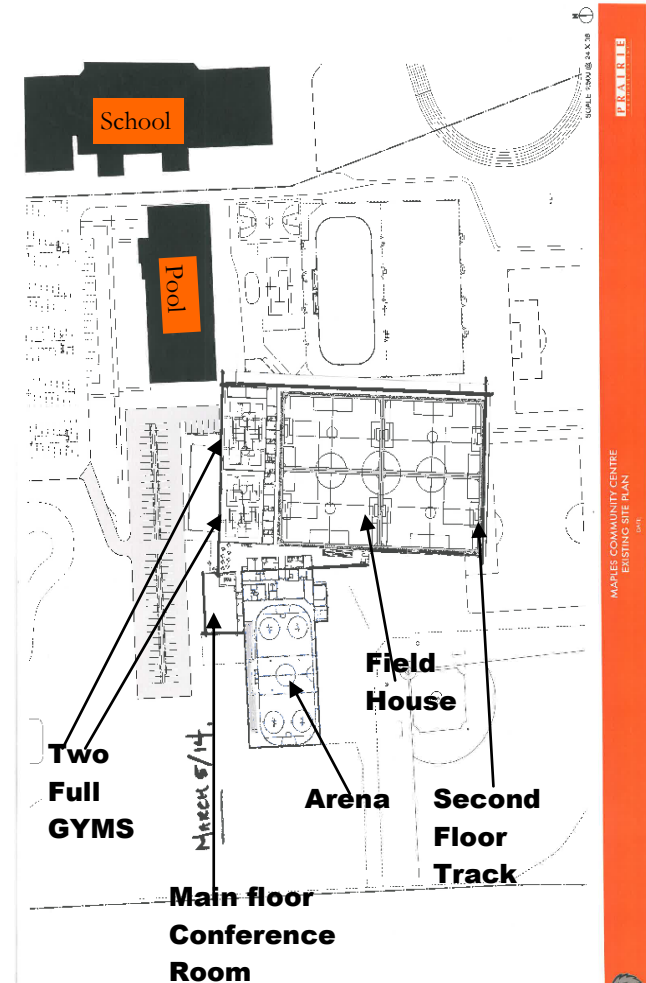
